**Under this agreement for 2017
Rockhampton State High School will receive**

\$565,000*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the % of 7-10 students passing English, Mathematics and Science (EMS) to 65%.
- Improve 2016 Year 9 NAPLAN Writing mean to 510.
- Improve student behaviour (fewer than 110 disciplinary absences per 1000 per term) and reduce unexplained absences (below 25%).
- Increase the % of Year 11 OP eligible students to 40% in 2018.

Our initiatives include

- Further developing new Learning Engagement Centre and restructure roles to accommodate student learning needs.
- Further developing Literacy resources, professional development and whole school Writing program.
- Continuing new roles and purchase of new programs to support student tracking and ensure timely accountability and behavioural action.
- Enhancing new Excellence program across all learning areas - Science Technology Engineering Maths (STEM) focus, and Writing Excellence program opportunities (EMP).

Increasing classing to provide targeted support and facilitate differentiation	\$72,000
Providing facilities enhancements and upgrades, and school resources	\$169,000
Provide additional teacher aides (Indigenous, Japanese, literacy)	\$80,000
Providing teacher professional development and resources (John Collins, David Rose, Pat Hipwell) in writing, literacy and metacognitive strategies	\$63,000
Implementing Behaviour Improvement Plan, personnel and resources	\$95,000
Purchasing additional STEM and Writing Excellence resources	\$86,000
